We recommend at least annual checkups with your veterinarian. We recommend an adult booster of rabies and an adult booster of FVR-C-P and then vaccination no more frequently than every three years, though further vaccination should not be necessary under normal circumstances. We do not recommend FeLV or FIP vaccines.

Under no circumstances shall this kitten or cat be sold, leased, or given to a pet shop, research laboratory or humane society or rescue organization. The purchaser agrees that the breeder/seller will be contacted before any transfer or placement of this cat or kitten and that any potential new owner must agree to abide by the terms of this contract. Under no circumstances shall this kitten or cat be declawed or have tendonectomy performed.

The purchaser agrees to keep this kitten or cat confined in a safe area of the home until the kitten or cat is confident enough to venture out into the rest of the home. Integration with other pets will be slow, careful and supervised. The purchaser agrees to give this kitten or cat at least four weeks to integrate into the home and agrees to understand that integration into a new home is very stressful and can take several weeks to accomplish.

Registration papers will be provided within 30 days of purchase or upon proof of neutering or spaying if not neutered or spayed when purchased.

This cat or kitten is guaranteed to be in good health, FeLV and FIV negative, and free of internal and external parasites on the date of sale. If a veterinarian examines this cat or kitten and discovers a medical problem or illness within two weeks of the date of sale, the breeder/seller must be notified immediately. The choice of refund or replacement if available will be at the discretion of the breeder/seller. The breeder/seller will not be responsible for any veterinary expenses unless prior approval is obtained from the breeder/seller.

The breeder/seller agrees to either refund the purchase price or replace the kitten or cat in the event that the kitten or cat perishes from a congenital defect. The breeder/seller must be notified immediately of the death of this kitten or cat and a veterinarian must perform a necropsy to determine the cause of death, costs for a necropsy to be covered by the breeder/seller.

The purchaser's signature indicates full understanding and compliance with the terms of this contract and agrees that this document is legal, binding, and can only be altered by signed approval of both parties.
